St Oliver Pilgrimage to Germany, 30th August – 3rd September 2024. Best wishes to Bishop Router, Fr Sweeney and all pilgrims visiting Lamspringe and Hildesheim at present, participating in the annual St. Oliver procession and celebrations. After his martyrdom at Tyburn, St Oliver's body was interred in the large abbey church in Lamspringe. The four major shrines dedicated to St Oliver are Drogheda and Oldcastle in Ireland, Downside Abbey, in Somerset, England and Lamspringe in

Germany. Parishioners have remained loyal to his memory over the centuries and a major relic of St Oliver is carried in procession through the streets of Lamspringe on the last Saturday of August every year. St Oliver is a patron of the diocese of Hildesheim. Many thanks to Tommy and Damien of St Oliver Plunkett Peace and Reconciliation Group for organising this pilgrimage. We celebrate the 400th anniversary of the birth of St Oliver in 2025.
