**St Malachy** was born near Armagh in 1094. He became Vicar of Ceallach, the reforming Bishop of Armagh and he continued this work of reform as Bishop of Connor and later, as Bishop of Armagh. Earlier he had restored the monastery of Bangor and in 1142 founded the monastery of Mellifont, the first Cistercian house in Ireland. He had visited St Bernard at Clairvaux on a journey to and from Rome in 1139. He also introduced the Canons Regular into Ireland. He set out from Ireland in 1148 to meet the Pope but died on his way at Clairvaux, where he is buried in the abbey church.
